Student Guidelines for the use of Google Chromebooks

Chromebook Classroom Guidelines

- 1. Students should always keep their Chromebook on the top of the desk with 'lid shut' when not in use.
- 2. Chromebooks are not to be placed on the floor.
- 3. At the start of the lesson, students should wait until instructed before using their device.
- 4. Students need to collect all belongings at the end of every lesson checking that they have their Chromebook.
- 5. Students are not to share their device or password with another student.

Chromebook General Guidelines

- 1. Students must bring their Chromebook to school and class each day, unless instructed by the Student Management Team that the Chromebook is not required, e.g., on a school sports day.
- 2. The only exception to this is PE classes. In this subject, students will leave their Chromebook in their locker unless instructed by their teacher to bring it.
- 3. Students are responsible for checking the news update feed on the College website where information will be posted about GEC events
- 4. Games are not to be played at school at any time on the Chromebook. School endorsed apps are exempt.
- 5. When carrying the Chromebook from class to class, it must always be closed.
- 6. Chromebooks are to be locked in lockers out of class time. This includes before school, recess, lunchtime and after school.
- 7. If students need to complete work on their Chromebook outside class time, they will be required to work either outside the Junior School Office or in the library.
- 8. Students are not to use their Chromebook in outdoor areas, unless participating in a specific class activity which is being supervised by a teacher.
- 9. Chromebooks must be placed in school bags when the student is coming to school, going home or attending a school excursion.
- 10. Students are not to take their Chromebook to activities outside of school, e.g., sporting events or excursions, unless directed by their teacher.
