

- CNED classes combine different years depending on the number of students. In 2020:
- 2 classes for mathematics [Year 7 + Year 9] and [Year 8 + Year 10],
- 1 class for history-geography [Year 9 + Year 10],
- 1 Class for French and history-geography for Years 7 + 8.



- Teachers organise their class to maximise student's learning by:
- Structuring in-class teaching around key learning outcomes,
- Explaining fundamental concepts,
- Following individual progress during exercise times.



- Students have access to CNED online materials and hard copy version for in-class learning:
- Hard copy booklets, assessment booklets, KPI dashboard,
- Regular assessments with assignments marked by CNED assessors.

CNED French Program Fees Structure

- ✓ CNED annual enrolment fees based on the chosen options Scolarite Internationale or A la Carte These fees include hard copy booklets, assessment booklets, KPI dashboard, assessors The invoice is issued in December for the following year,
- ✓ **ESFM Administration and Tuition fees** for CNED subjects and Spanish language courses outside school time The administration includes the coordination with CNED (enrolments, assessments sent to CNED etc.) The invoice is issued every semester and the fee amount depends on the number of student
- ✓ **GEC Tuition fees** for CNED subjects in school time

 The invoice is issued every school term and the fee amount depends on the number of students
- ✓ All fees are payable before each invoicing term and non-refundable.


Students must be enrolled at Glen Eira College to join ESFM.

CNED FRENCH PROGRAM – THE LEARNING BENEFITS

The best of the two school systems: Possibility to follow a French Education program over Y 7-10 four years along with the Australian curriculum, compatible with SEAL program. Possibility to complete VCE French Units 3 and 4 (1) one year ahead of Year 12 freeing up **Y11** study time for other VCE subjects and VCE Extension in the final year. Possibility of VCE Extension with a First Year University subject related to French to Y 12 contribute to VCE and ATAR score. **DELF** Possibility to take the DELF (2) exam - Level B1 in Year 8 and level B2 in Year 9. Berthe Mouchette Mouchette" organised by the Alliance Française de Melbourne.

- (1) Units 1 and 2 are automatically validated if CNED program was followed during the four preceding years (Year 7 to 10).
- (2) DELF (Diploma of Studies in French Language): Awarded by the French Ministry of National Education, it certifies candidate's French language proficiency as a foreign language in all language skills (speaking, written and oral comprehension). DELF is valid for life and internationally recognised, **DELF B2** allows foreign students to obtain admission into a French university without a French proficiency entry test.


