For 2027, Glen Eira College will offer:

The purpose of this policy is to explain Glen Eira College's commitment to making sure every member of our school community, regardless of their background or personal attributes, is treated with respect and dignity. This policy should be read alongside the following Department of Education policies:

- Four academic scholarships of \$250 for Year 7, 2027 students. Students who maintain an outstanding academic record will automatically receive another \$250 scholarship in Year 8.
- Criteria for the award of scholarships will be the demonstration of the student's talents in academic, leadership and sports/hobby areas.
- The primary measure of the student's ability and potential is a one-page confidential report from the student's grade 5 or 6 teacher, endorsed by the student's current principal.
- Applications will be assessed by a panel of Glen Eira College staff and Council representatives.
- Successful applicants will be announced in December and awarded at their Grade 6 graduation.
- All information will be confidential and used solely for the purpose of this scholarship.
- **The closing date for applications is Friday 27th November 2026.**
